Lake Koronis
Beautiful Lake Koronis, with its three islands, is located just south of Paynesville. It is part of the North Fork Crow River Watershed District located down river from Rice Lake.

Lake Koronis has 33 miles of shoreline and is a great place for all kinds of water activities. Lake Koronis is a beautiful lake in all seasons. It also has good access for the public with five boat landings and two parks with public beaches. Fishing for walleyes, sunfish, bass, and other fish is great year-round. The lake is 132 feet deep at the maximum and has 3,014 acres of surface water.





Lake Koronis Recreational Trail
The trail provides a safe, non-motorized bicycle/pedestrian trail that will connect the city of Paynesville with Lake Koronis and will eventually make a scenic loop around Lake Koronis. Phase one has opened along Old Lake Road.



The trail is beautiful all year long for bikers, hikers, in-line skaters, skiers, runners, leisure strollers, and walkers. When complete, visitors will enjoy over 25 miles of trail. Access to the trail will be available by designated parking areas at three different points along the trail corridor.
