Snowmobile Signs

- Reassuring Trail Signs**
 - Assures the user they are on the trail.
 - Indicates changes in trail direction. The user must make a right or left turn.
 - Trail is curvy.
 - Trail is splitting or merging.
- Warning Signs**
 - Indicates a one-way trail where access is possible from another trail.
 - Stop and look for traffic before proceeding.
 - Indicates there is possible traffic ahead.
- Information Signs**
 - Indicates an area where caution is necessary.
 - Indicates there is a stop ahead.
 - Indicates trails and areas where snowmobile use is prohibited.
- Stay on Trail Signs**
 - Please stay on trail.
 - Please stay on trail by MN DNR.

For your safety and enjoyment please observe the following:
- Do not wander off the trails. You have permission to ride the marked trails only.
 - Do not damage any trees, shrubs, etc.
 - Do not disturb wildlife or any livestock.
 - Do not litter. Dispose of trash properly.
 - Be careful when crossing roadways and cross only at 90 degrees.
 - Remember that lakes are never completely safe due to currents, springs and changing temperatures.
 - Carry a compass when out in the woods or at night.
 - Remember all snowmobilers are judged by the actions of a few. Please do not cause any disturbances or damage any property.
 - Where trails follow public roads, obey all traffic laws and regulations, such as: keep to the right, dim lights, follow speed limits, etc.
 - Snowmobiles are prohibited or restricted from operating on certain public streets in many towns. When in these areas watch for marked streets or check with city officials.
